MASTERSON METHOD EQUINE BODYWORK CLINIC

Dwayne Johnstone is a certified Equine Sports Massage Therapist, licensed by CHRB and Referred by State Veterinary. He is also certified Level 1 Reiki and is currently working on the phases to become certified Level 2. He studied directly under Jim Masterson, founder of the Masterson Method.

The Masterson Method is a unique method of bodywork developed by Jim Masterson by working with and watching Chiropractors, Massage Therapist, and other professionals work. Jim began noticing the horse's response to certain techniques and how they react getting an idea what works and what is not working. Jim Masterson also has a background in natural horsemanship training which he incorporated it into this method of bodywork. This Method of Bodywork consists of many modalities including advanced techniques of Myofascial Release, Cranial Sacral, and many others, This Method is also very result oriented which we can feel and see improvements as we work with the horse by using touch, or movement in a relax state to release tension and restriction. This method also targets the deeper muscle layer which traditional massage cannot get to them, and doesn't matter how much pressure is used without the horse bracing. This doesn't replace chiropractic or massage. This method of bodywork is for the active healthy horse.
